Tips for your safety

Be equipped to go off-piste

- Off-piste skiers and snowboarders are responsible for their own safety. You should have an avalanche beacon round your neck and a shovel and probe in your backpack.

Take heed of the avalanche risk

- Information about the current risk of avalanche in specific locations can be obtained at the freeride checkpoints at the Corvatsch summit station, the Murtèl middle station and the Furtschellas middle station as well as at www.slf.ch.

Respect the wildlife quiet zones

- Various wildlife quiet zones have been set up in the forest areas. Please respect the markings, barriers and information boards. www.wildruhezonen.ch.

General

- Use public transport to travel to and from the area whenever possible.
- Keep to footpaths or existing routes across forested areas.
- Do not linger near the edge of the forest.
- Avoid forested areas at dawn and dusk.
- Take your rubbish home with you.
- Enjoy the silence of the forest and don't disturb it unnecessarily.
- Don't let your dog run freely through the forested area.
- Think of yourself as a welcome guest of Nature.
