

## **VIP Snow Night**

### **WHEN THE MOUNTAIN IS YOURS ALL NIGHT LONG**



It is a pictorial icon of the Upper Engadin – the floodlit piste on the Corvatsch. Snow Night is held every Friday for the general public. On all the other evenings, however, the night piste can be privately rented – offering unforgettable skiing fun that only the Corvatsch can offer.

Two flaming torches at the entrance of the Corvatsch aerial cableway signal that tonight is a very special night – or to be more precise, VIP Snow Night. And this means much more than just perfect skiing. For example, in the spacious cabin, hors d'oeuvres and a glass of champagne are served. Chatting away over tasty appetisers, you swing up the mountainside, while down below the dream slope sparkles under the spotlights. This, the longest night piste in Switzerland, is 4.2 kilometres long. It has just been freshly groomed, a white velvet carpet stretching out before you. And tonight it belongs to you, just you and your friends.

#### **At night, the piste is at its best**

At the top, you descend into the clear, cold Engadin night. You step into your skis, zip your jacket up to your chin, and off you go. The snow feels soft and has good grip, your turns are smooth and effortless. It is almost as if you were skiing on powder. The piste is never as good as it is on VIP Snow Night. For it has just been freshly prepared; the piste-grooming vehicle left its last tracks just 15 minutes earlier. Carving on this virgin snow is a completely different feeling than early in the morning, when the snow is fresh but hard. And best of all: as only you and your friends are on the piste, it remains in this fabulous condition for several downhill runs.

#### **At night, skiing is at its most intensive**

In any case, skiing at night is much more intensive than during the day. This is due to the “tunnel effect” – you see the floodlit piste in front of you, but everything around it is shrouded in darkness. As a result, you are more focused, your turns are more precise, the airstream is sharper, you breathe faster, your pulse rises... making occasional breaks all the more important. Breathe in deeply and rest your burning leg muscles. Soak up the tranquillity on the mountainside and gaze at the lights down in the valley. A truly magical moment – just for you and your friends.

### Three restaurants will fulfil your culinary wishes

Once you have arrived at the bottom, you can make your way directly to the cable car boarding platform. You do not need a lift pass and there is no queueing at the turnstile. Drinks are awaiting you – which you can enjoy at your leisure as you do not have to wait for the next cable car. For it will depart when you are ready; you can decide how many trips up the mountain you make and when you want to stop for refreshments or a bite to eat. In addition, there are three restaurants on the mountain, ready to fulfil your culinary wishes. VIP Snow Night Corvatsch offers everything you could possibly need for an unforgettable night with your friends.

### Facts & Figures VIP Snow Night

- **4.2 km long piste**, the longest floodlit piste in Switzerland
- **Transport** on the Surlej-Murtèl aerial cableway
- **Pistes are freshly groomed** between 5.00 and 6.45pm
- **Minimum no. of persons** for VIP Snow Night: 1!
- **In operation** from the beginning of December to the beginning of April, depending on the snow situation
- **Bookable** every night except Friday
- **Ideal for company events** or club excursions – or a perfect gift for friends who like skiing
- **Tip:** Don't forget to take along a pair of sunglasses and ski goggles with as light-coloured lenses as possible
- **Incidentally:** Whether it is snowing, the sky is overcast or it is a clear starry night, visibility is always good on Snow Night.
- **Caution:** Distances and speeds are more difficult to gauge at night than during the day.

### Prices VIP Snow Night (incl. 7,7% VAT)

- Ski slope Snow Night: CHF 5'000.-
  - Operation of the aerial cableway from 7.00 – 10.00pm
  - SOS ski patrol
- Each additional hour of aerial cableway operation: CHF 1'500.- (at the latest until 12.00 midnight)
- Food and refreshments on request. Virtually everything is possible:
  - hors d'oeuvres on the boarding platform and/or in the cable car cabin
  - drinks bar on the platform
  - three restaurants for your evening meal: Murtèl middle station, Alpetta, Hossa Bar
